**Bylaw # 45 Renumbered # 1989-02**

**A BYLAW TO CLOSE A PORTION OF CARLETON STREET**

1. **THAT** the Council does close to public use a portion of the street known as Carleton Street.
2. **THAT** the portion of the said street hereby closed to public use pursuant to Section 1 of this By-Law is as follows:

**ALL** that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the Town of Digby, County of Digby and Province of Nova Scotia and being a portion of Carleton Street lying east of Maiden Lane.

**BEING AND INTENDED TO BE** the portion of Carleton Street lying from the East Side of Maiden Lane to original low water mark as detailed in the Year of Our Lord 1783 A.D.

3. **THAT** the portion of Carleton Street as described in Section 2 of this by-law be closed and that all rights of public user heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the Town may sell and convey the portion so closed.

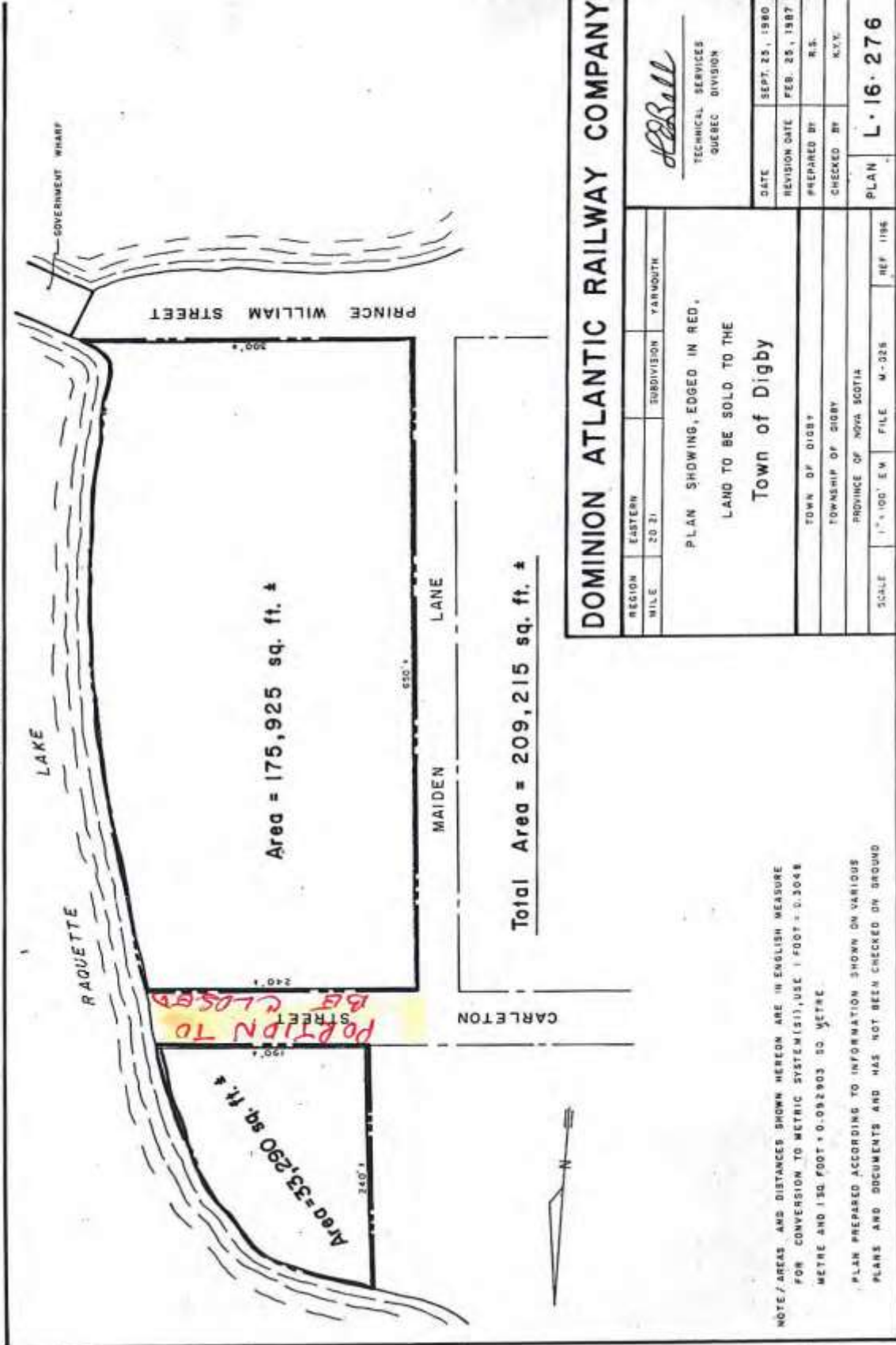





This by-law respecting the closing of a portion of Carleton Street, passed by the Council of the Town of Digby on November 14, 1988 is approved, pursuant to Section Z4 of the Municipal Affairs Act, with the following amendments:

1. The third paragraph of Section Z, being the description of the street to be closed, is amended by deleting the period at the end of the paragraph and substituting therefor a comma, and adding thereto the following words and punctuation "and which is shown in yellow and the plan attached as "Schedule A" to this by-law, identified as Dominion Atlantic Railway Company L-16-276, dated September 25, 1980 and revised February 25, 1987."
2. The identification "Schedule A" is placed on the Dominion Atlantic Railway Company L-16-276 plan, and it is attached to the by-law.
