BY-LAW NO. 2003 - 02

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL THE BY-LAW RESPECTING DEPOSITS BY CANDIDATES AT AN ELECTION # 1979-02

WHEREAS the *Municipal Elections Act* Section 51 requires that every nomination paper shall be accompanied by a deposit of two hundred dollars, provided that the council may by by-law specify that a lesser deposit, or no deposit shall be required.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Digby By-Law Respecting Deposits By Candidates At An Election # 1979-02 be repealed.
